Danger

Hazard Statements

H290 May be corrosive to metals. H314 Causes severe skin burns and eye damage.

Prevention

P234 Keep only in original packaging. P260 Do not breathe dust, fume, mist, vapors or spray. P264 Wash thoroughly after handling. P280 Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection, face protection.

Response

P303+361+353 IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove, take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water, shower. P304 +340 IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. P305 +351+338 IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. P310 Immediately call a POISON CENTER, doctor or physician. P301+330+331 IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. P363 Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. P390 Absorb spillage to prevent material damage.

Storage

P405 Store locked up. P406 Store in a corrosive resistant, container with a resistant inner liner.

Disposal

P501 Dispose of contents or container in accordance with local and national regulations.
